Clubs who want flyers given out on the Team Sydney stand should bring them at the start of the day or send files in for Team Sydney to print (100 copies maximum). Please adhere to template with your sport boldly stated at <u>top</u> of front page.</p> <p>Wally Salinger pointed out need for enquiry book to record contact details for clubs to follow up. TS board will provide necessary book. Tri skills will provide insurance.</p>

DR suggested NMG should give us a finished product for consideration before we consider any support for idea. Other competitions like the Bingham Cup should be included.
