8	MARDI GRAS FAIR DAY	
8.1	Stalls –layout and demonstrations.	
	<p>JB advised that we are still awaiting NMG’s confirmation to our suggested lay out plan for Fair Day. Bump-in with vehicles can only be done between 7-8am. After which time all vehicles must be clear of the site - The police will be making an inspection of stall around 9am – Members Clubs were advised that TS will be supplying sponsors water for each stall and you should make your own arrangements for having an esky on hand if you want to keep it cool – JB highlighted NMG concerns which have already been laid out in his weekly updates. Please make sure that you check this fully so that we all comply with their requests.</p> <p>Sponsors: If any stall holder has any individual sponsors where details of their involvement with your club on display JB needs a list asap so that they can be cleared with NMG</p> <p>Pool: final arrangements are to be confirmed but it is shaping up as a great innovation to our Sports Village. For the “drag” relay teams will consist of Wettone, Stingers, Convicts and possibly Frontrunners. GR to provide Megan with WM contact details. TS will be having access to 4 lanes on the far side of the pool with our own entrance separate from the public general entrance which is located on the City Road side of the Pool. WS to arrange for roping of the “them/us” areas of the pool – Email from Megan is quoted. So please reply to her direct if you have any questions:</p>	

There will be a swimming relay held at the Victoria Park Pool during Fair Day as part of the "aquatic" demonstrations. Teams will consist of 4 people and 50m free will be swum by each member. There will be no cost to participants or spectators.

You can submit one male, one female and one mixed team but no one can swim more than once and they must be bona fide members of your club. This is meant to just be a little bit of fun rather than a full on competition hence the dresses. Speaking of which, there will be four generic polyester numbers (size 18-20) that are easy to change in/out of and will be selected out of a box in a "lucky dip" type situation to make it a little fairer.

To even things up slightly between the sexes it is proposed that females do not need to wear the dresses but will need to get out of the pool (independently) and tag the next swimmer.

All these rules are embryonic and need fine tuning - most likely everything will be finalised on the day with a small conference with team captains deciding the final format etc.

I will be taking final entries pool side during the water polo demonstration (11.30-12.00). Depending on final team numbers the warm up will be approximately 10 minutes from 12.00 to 12.10. At 12.10 the final rules etc and heats will be confirmed with racing commencing soon after.

All augers well for a very successful Sports Festival here in Sydney with interstate team taking part.</p> <p>Masters Events:</p> <p>Wayne Morgan gave brief details about the various Masters Events that are happening. The most important are the World masters to be held in Sydney in 2009. TS will be sending out a summary of these events and will be putting links onto our website.</p> <p>Asia Pacific Games:</p> <p>GL distributed the first newsletter form GLISA Asia Pacific acknowledging the fact that little information has been forthcoming to date. GR pointed out that they should change their name of "Participate" as this was already in use as the FGG newsletter. GL assured us that this would happen for future editions. The press release for Melbourne 2008 will be at the conclusion of Midsumma on February 11 and when we receive this it will be sent out to our members. GLISA/Asia Pacific Games will be having a stall in our Sports Village at Fair Day where the latest information will be available. Concern was expressed about the financial set up and GL advised that they should be able to confirm mid March if they have been successful in obtaining the require funding that they are after.
