Title: TSMGSF Medals 2007

Portfolios involved: All

Proposed duration: 2 minutes

Estimated financial impact: \$0 until clubs order medals

Proposed activity or matter for discussion: No discussion required

1. The medals previously used, supplied by Endeavour Medallion Castings, will be available for \$4.80 each. This is the same as the cost in previous years, except for last year when there was an added expense for "set up costs" to produce a medal without the Mardi Gras logo on the reverse side. The "brusha cord" still costs \$40 for 50 metres, which adds approximately \$0.75 per medal, i.e. total cost of \$5.55 per medal. I am fairly sure this is a price before GST, but have left a message with John Erikson asking him to confirm that point.
2. I have sourced a cheaper generic type medal, available in "gold", "silver" and "bronze", onto which our team Sydney logo "button" can be glued. The supplier is holding approximately 100 of our logo buttons, which were produced earlier this year, and he will glue them on for us at no extra charge. Additional logo buttons can be ordered at a cost of \$0.70 each. These medals are most suitable to have engraving on the reverse side if any clubs, or recipients, wished to have them engraved. The cost of each medal is \$3.00, including GST.
3. Last week I attended the Sports Council Meeting with samples of both the previously used medals and several styles in the cheaper range of medals. There was a mixed reaction from the delegates with some preferring to use the heavier (old) medals and others happy to use the much less expensive (new) ones. There was a general consensus regarding which style, of the different samples displayed, they preferred.
